

The statutory requirements related to institutional controls contained in Part 213 have been amended since 2007 and, therefore, the references, directions, and forms contained in Operational Memorandum No. 6 are outdated. All current institutional control forms and public notice requirements under Part 213 are located on the Departments of Environmental Quality and Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Storage Tank Information Database web page under Forms & Documents, Forms.
