MEDC Goals and Role

- Streamline and clarify Act 381 related to non-environmental activities
- Participated fully in discussions as a partner in the process

Legislative Changes (or Not)

- Capturing MSF TIR for LSRRF and reporting
- Increasing requirement for MSF Board approval from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000
- Core Community (QLGU) discussion and Act 146 of 2000

Guidance Changes

- Cover historic building documentation as a demolition activity available statewide
- Increase allowable cost for Brownfield plan and work plan reimbursement to \$30,000
- Dredging costs allowed under site preparation on private property and public waterways for economic development purposes
