

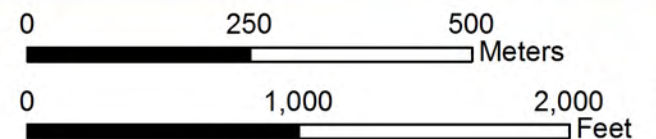


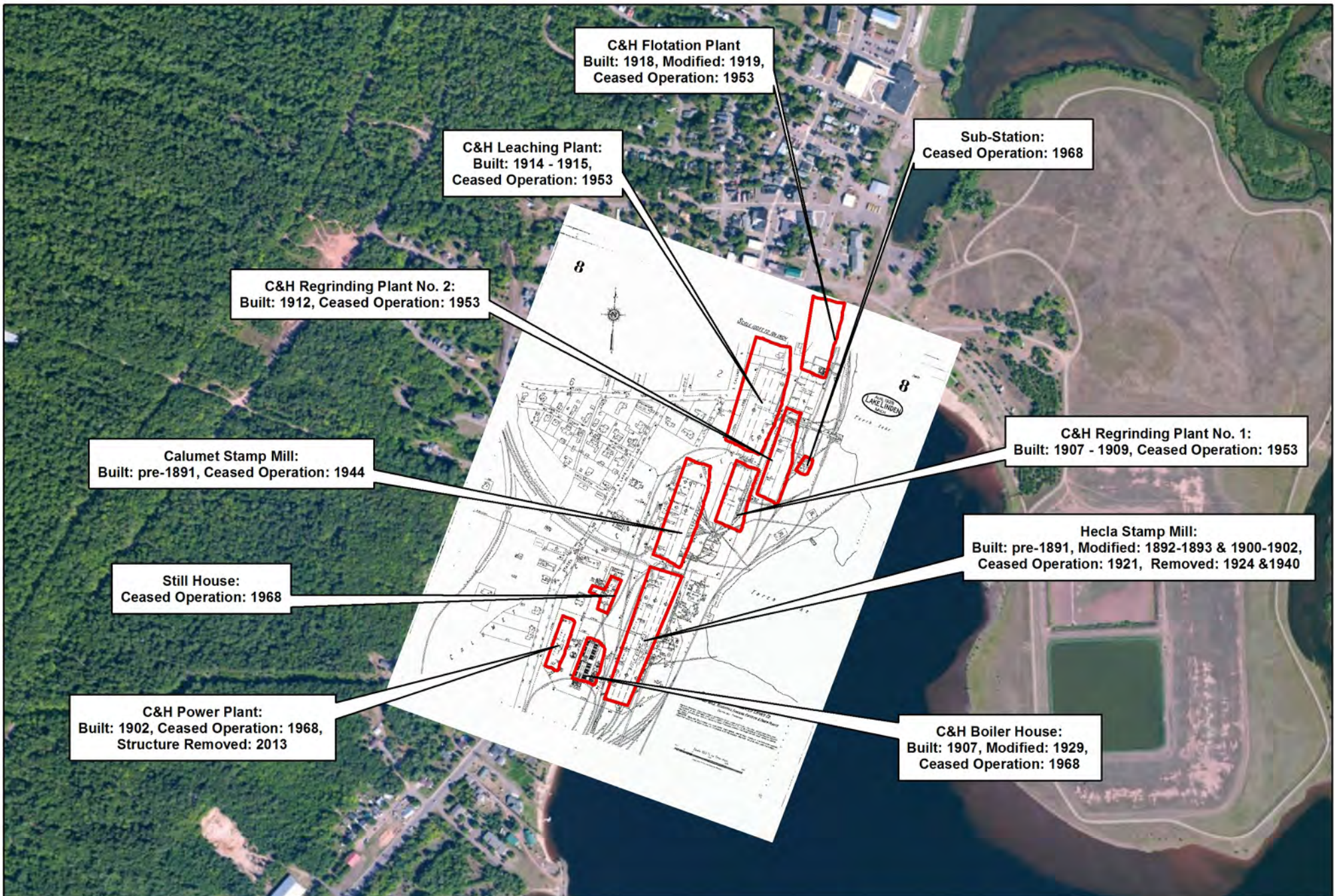
Historic Building Locations

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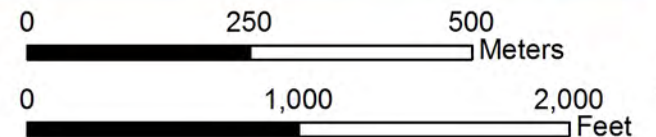


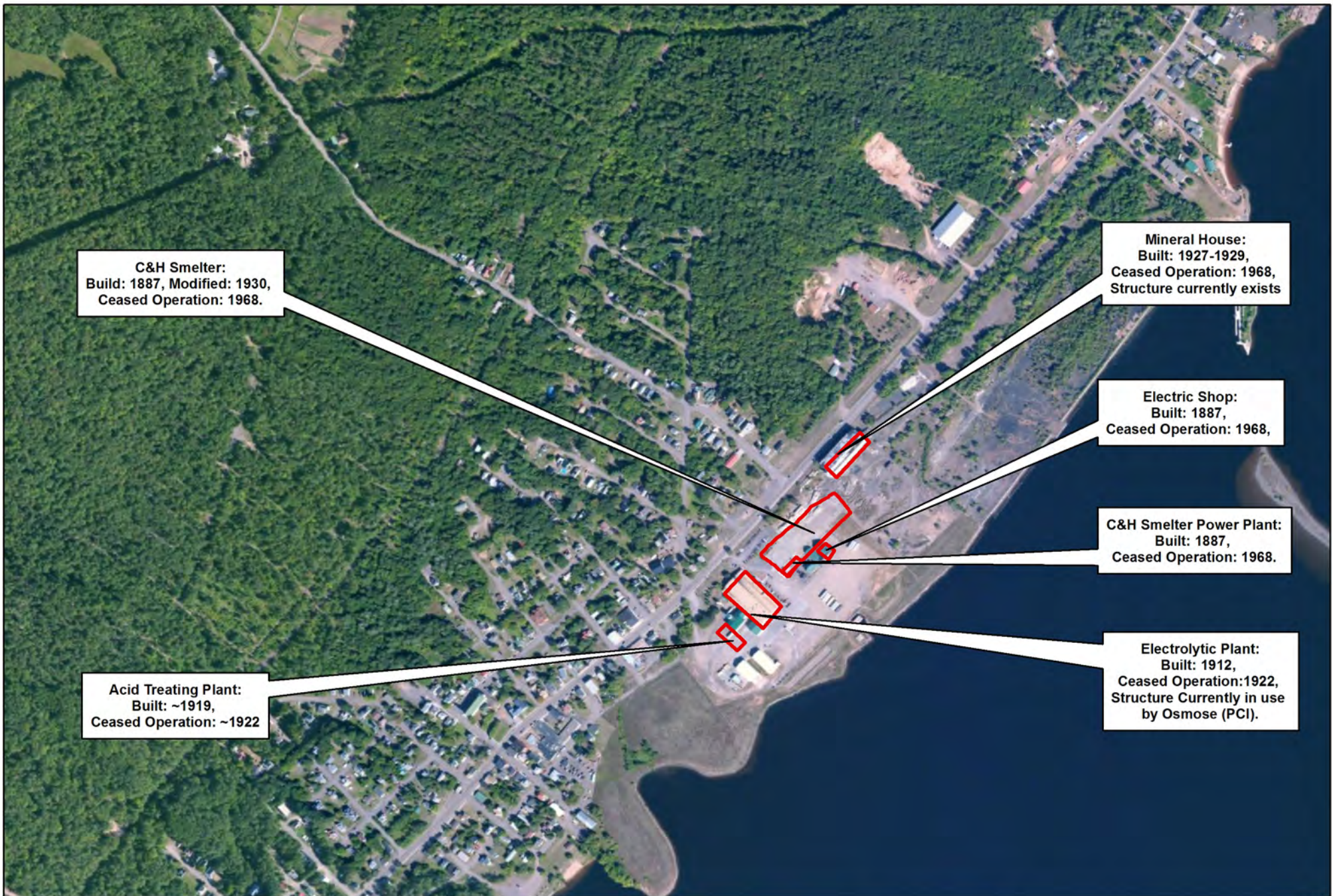
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C&H Smelter:

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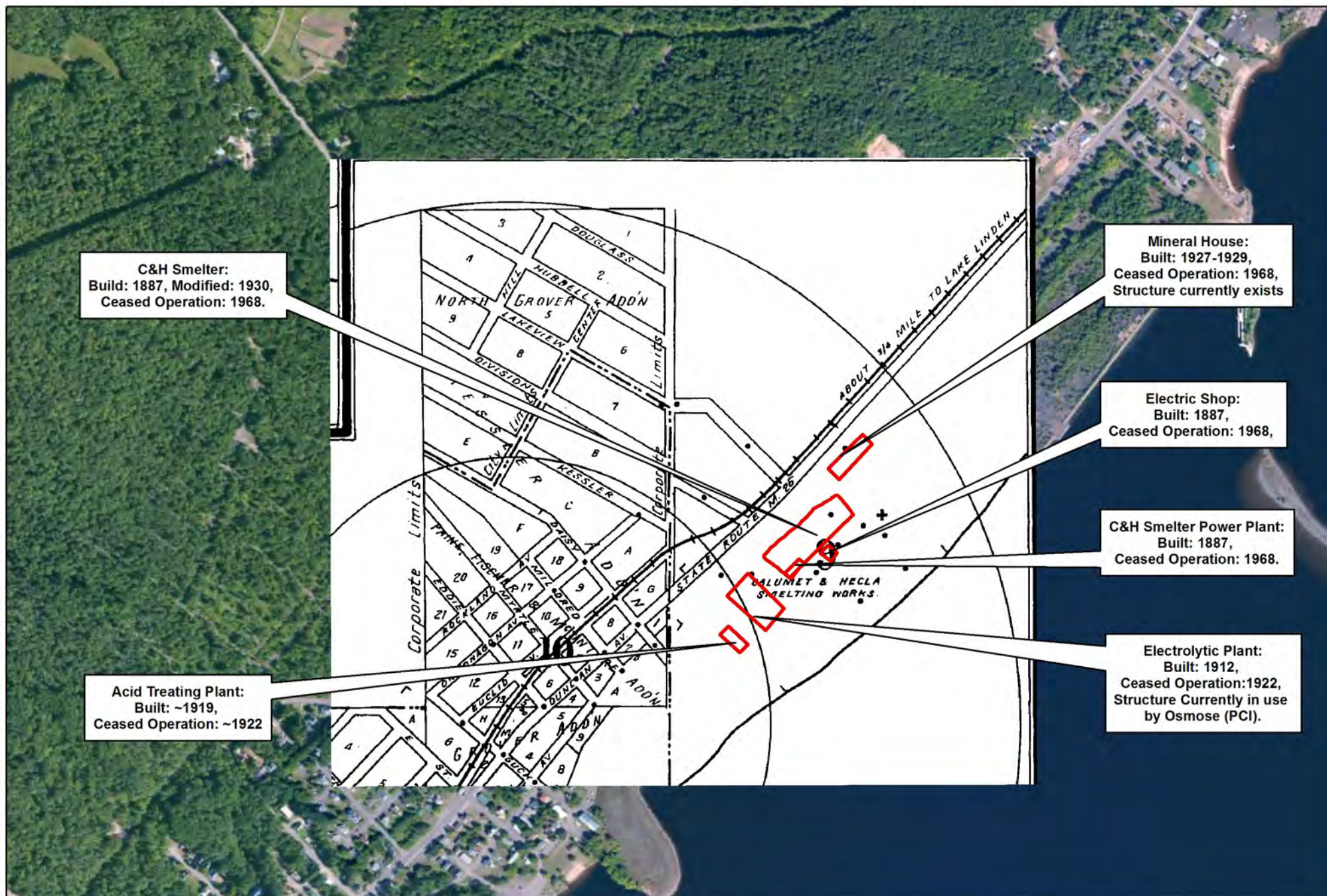
