The workshops are offered at no-cost to POTWs treating 2.5 mgd or greater. Other utilities, state and local government officials, and interested parties may participate on a space-available basis. You will be notified shortly if your application is approved. Although the training events will remain free of cost for all participants, only POTW staff will be eligible for reimbursement through travel scholarships.

WEF is not responsible for travel arrangements or costs. POTW staff traveling greater than 100 miles may be eligible for a travel scholarship. Call the number below for details.

The training will focus heavily on the VSAT™ wastewater software. All participants must comply with COPYRIGHT, DISCLAIMER, AND NOTICE TO USERS statements associated with the software.

In addition, all participants understand training on the use of the VSAT™ software shall not be offered by private entities without prior written permission of the copyright holders. The software is provided at no-cost and details are available at www.vsatusers.net.

You will need a laptop computer for the training. If you do not have access to a laptop call the number listed below and WEF will supply one for use during the workshop. Confirmed registrants will receive a pre-conference information package, including logistical information that will be emailed to the address indicated on the application.
