Attached is our **scope** of work for PFAS sampling at the Montague site.

For locations, the only change from when we spoke in May is that we decided to include a sample of the site water supply. We decontaminate our sampling equipment with that as the wash step.

**Schedule:** I confirmed with Ashley McElmurry this morning by email that she will be coming out Aug 22. I have two AECOM staff who will be collecting these samples and they have attended the AECOM training and reviewed our internal sampling guidance document. Our plan is to collect samples on Aug 22 and 23 in case things go slow.
