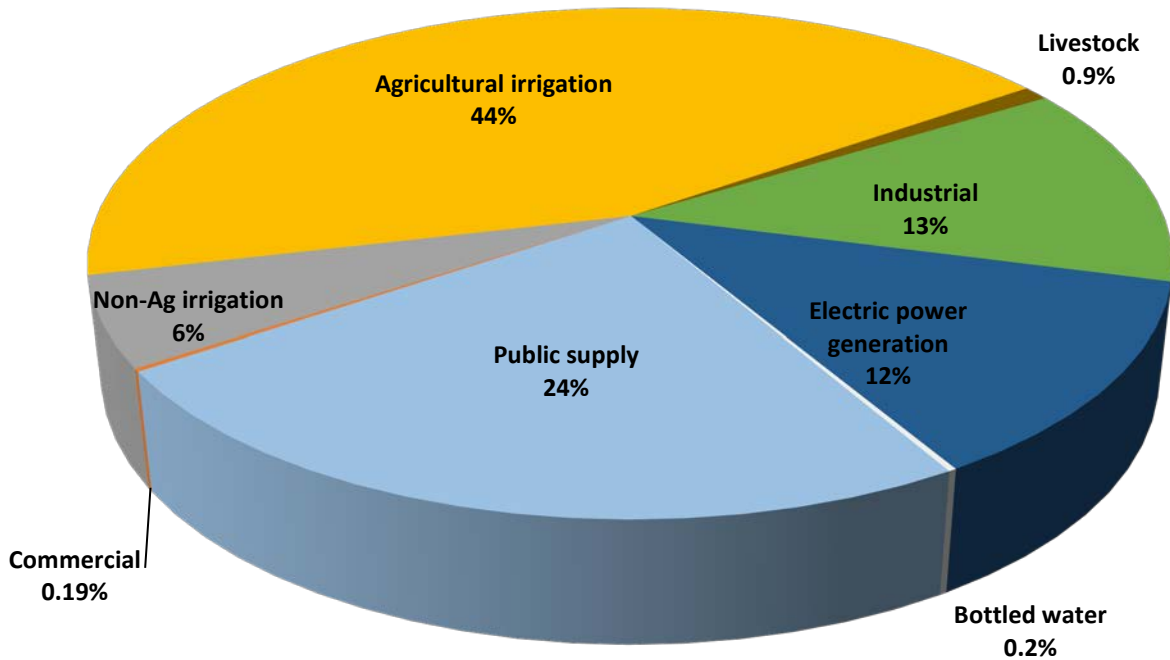

Water by the Numbers

- In the Great Lakes: 6,000,000,000,000,000 gallons
- In 1 inch of rain falling over 1 township area (36 square miles): 625,600,000 gallons
- Consumptive use by all Michigan (power, industry, agriculture, etc.): 615 MGD
