Fiscal Year 2017 Annual Report**

Summary

The Land and Water Management Permit Fee Fund was created within the Department of Treasury. The Department of Treasury may receive money or other assets from any source for deposit into the fund and shall direct the investment of the fund. The Department of Treasury shall annually present to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) an accounting of the amount of money in the fund, and the DEQ serves as the administrator of the fund for auditing purposes.

Section 324.30113(5) of Part 301, Inland Lakes and Streams, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, states:

The department shall annually report to the legislature how money in the fund was expended during the previous fiscal year.
