



MACDC SUMMARY OF 301 ACTIVITIES (2014)

Exempt Activities include:

- Sediment removal to original contours
- Reshaping side slopes
- Bank stabilization to address erosion
- Culvert replacement w/extensions of 24 ft max
- Armoring, lining, piping in previous footprint
- Replacement of existing control structures
- Repair of stabilization structures
- Emergency reconstruction of recently damaged parts of drains

The General Permit Category for County Drains includes:

- Clear span bridges
- Short culverts
- Culvert end sections, headwalls and wingwalls
- Riprap
- Long culverts
- Drain realignments
- Installation of vanes and riffles

Public Notice Projects include:

- Widening, Deepening, Straightening
- Drain Extensions
- Adding Branches
- Relocating or other Realignments
- Any exempt/general permit activity on drains established after 1972 without previous permit
- Any general permit activity that does not meet GP screening criteria

Projects under Drain Code on pre-1973 or previously permitted drains:

- Sediment removal to original contours
- Reshaping side slopes

- Repair of stabilization structures
- Emergency reconstruction of recently damaged parts of drains

Projects under Drain Code that meets Drain General Permit category criteria for:

- Installation of vanes and riffles

Other Projects such as:

- Any activity that does NOT meet GP screening criteria
- NOT performed under Drain Code
