On October 27, 2014, the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing (BCAL) issued a *Special Investigation Report* recommending disciplinary action of your adult foster care license for G and G Cloud Nine. During this special investigation, Licensing Consultant Maureen Fisher determined that you were in violation of two adult foster care licensing rules. The cited rule violations directly jeopardized the health, safety and welfare of adult foster care residents.


On October 16, 2014, you requested the closure of your adult foster care licenses for G and G Cloud Nine and Maes Cloud Nine Too. Pursuant to this request, BCAL is administratively closing your adult foster care license for G and G Cloud Nine. If within 30 days of receipt of this certified letter, you wish to object to the closure of your license to operate G and G Cloud Nine, you may do so, in writing, to BCAL at the letterhead address.

Due to the severity of the rule violations found at the Maes Cloud Nine Too facility, BCAL has issued a *Notice of Intent to Revoke* this license. Instructions for appealing the revocation of this license are provided in the *Notice of Intent*.

Please note that it is unlawful to provide adult foster care without a license. For more information regarding this misdemeanor offense, you may refer to the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.713(13).
