Dear Senator Caswell and Representative MacGregor:

Section 10c(3) of 2011 PA 198 requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to report the following information upon implementation:

In accordance with the Social Welfare Act, Act 280 of 1939, Section 400.10c, this is to advise that an automated interface between the department and Michigan State Police (MSP) has been established to send a file containing public assistance recipient and applicant address information. This information will be used to assist MSP in apprehending individuals subject to arrest under an outstanding felony warrant, an outstanding warrant for extradition arising from a criminal charge in another jurisdiction, or a material witness in a criminal case arising from a felony charge. The automated interface was successfully implemented on June 27, 2013.
