Michigan Career and Technical Institute Tuition Rates

MCTI conducts vocational and technical training programs and provides the supportive services needed to prepare Michigan citizens with disabilities for competitive employment. The following fee schedule will be effective as of Fall Term (September) 2015.

We operate on a four (4) term calendar from September through July. Each term the charges for tuition and room and board will be as follows:
