DAY 1: 5 p.m. to 6:20 p.m. on Tuesday, February 15

- At the conclusion of this panel, interested applicants will have the opportunity to sign up for a one-hour time slot on Day 2.

DAY 2: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, February 16

Application and Round 1 of Interviews. *Applicants sign up for ONLY a one-hour time slot.

Campus Location: Student Services Building, Room: Career Services Center

- This is NOT an open event; pre-registration takes place on Day 1.
- Applicants must bring a copy of their résumé and unofficial transcripts as computers, and copy and fax machines will NOT be available.
- Casual dress attire is preferred.
- During the one-hour time slot, applicants will complete a written exercise, application form, and undergo a 10-minute behavioral-based interview with a DHS employee.
- Applicants will be notified immediately if they are selected to come back on Day 3 for Round 2 of Interviews.

DAY 3: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Thursday, February 17

Round 2 of Interviews. *Applicants sign up for ONLY a one-hour time slot.

Campus Location: Student Services Building, Room: Career Services Center

- This is NOT an open event; applicants will be invited by DHS to take part in Day 3.
- Applicants must bring a photocopy of their driver’s license and social security card, in addition to five professional references as computers, and copy and fax machines will NOT be available.
- Professional dress attire is expected.
- During this one-hour time slot, applicants will complete a 45-minute behavioral-based interview with two DHS employees.
