Boilerplate Report – Section 588(2) Reports 1-4

Section 588(2) of 2010 Public Act 190 (Enrolled House Bill No. 5882) requires the Department of Human Services to report monthly on the number of children enrolled in the subsidized guardianship program and foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

Report 1: October 2010

During October 2010, 129 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During October 2010, 79 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

Report 2: November 2010

During November 2010, 142 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During November 2010, 83 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

Report 3: December 2010

During December 2010, 150 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During December 2010, 95 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

Report 4: January 2011

During January 2011, 160 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During January 2011, 101 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.
