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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

In the Matter of:

On December 11, 2014, the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing issued *Special Investigation Report*, #2015D0219006, recommending the revocation of the child care center license of 2168 Montessori, LLC. Julie Powers is the Administrator of 2168 Montessori, LLC and therefore signs on behalf of the Licensee corporation. In settlement of all issues raised in that *Special Investigation Report*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Julie Powers neither admits nor denies that the allegations set forth in the *Special Investigation Report* are true; however, Ms. Powers admits to a violation of the Child Care Organizations Act or a licensing rule promulgated under the Act.
- 2) Julie Powers understands that the child care center license for 2168 Montessori, LLC will be revoked, effective with the date of signature by the representative of Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing.
- 3) Julie Powers understands that under MCL 722.125, Section 15(1), a person who provides child care without a license is guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by up to 90 days imprisonment and/or a \$1,000 fine. Ms. Powers agrees to immediately cease providing care to unrelated children at the child care center or at any other location.
- 4) Julie Powers understands that she is waiving her right to appeal the *Special Investigation Report* and an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.
- 5) Julie Powers agrees not to apply for a license or certificate of registration for a Child Care Organization licensed or registered under the Child Care Organization Act for a period of two years, and agrees not to be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant for a period of two years from the effective date of this agreement.
