## **Boilerplate Report – Section 588(2) Reports 7-11**

Section 588(2) of 2010 Public Act 190 (Enrolled House Bill No. 5882) requires the Department of Human Services to report monthly on the number of children enrolled in the subsidized guardianship program and foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

### **Report 7: April 2011**

During April 2011, 142 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During April 2011, 138 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

### **Report 8: May 2011**

During May 2011, 151 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During May 2011, 156 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

### **Report 9: June 2011**

During June 2011, 156 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During June 2011, 165 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

### **Report 10: July 2011**

During July 2011, 157 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During July 2011, 175 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.

### **Report 11: August 2011**

During August 2011, 172 children were served by the foster care – children with serious emotional disturbance waiver program.

During August 2011, 196 children were enrolled in the guardianship assistance program.
