Dear Senator Caswell and Representative MacGregor:

Section 617 of 2013 Public Act No. 59 requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to report the following information:

- *The number and percentage of public assistance recipients, categorized by type of assistance received, who were no longer eligible for assistance because of their status in the law enforcement information network.*

During the period October 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, a total of 790 recipients were determined no longer eligible for assistance because of their status in the law enforcement information network.
