**Section 677 of 2012 Public Act No. 200 requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to report the following information on a monthly basis:**

**1. Current percentage of FIP cases involved in JET employment activities:**

The percentage of FIP cases “involved in JET employment activities” for November 2012 was **50.4%**. The table below provides a break-down of participants coded as “Work First” and includes all FIP recipients (federal and state-funded) who attended orientation and started an activity.

**2. Current percentage of FIP cases that meet federal work participation requirement.**

The current percentage of FIP cases that met federal work participation requirements for FY 2012, year-to-date (October 2011-August 2012), was **40.28%**.
