**1. Current percentage of FIP cases involved in JET employment activities:**

**2. Current percentage of FIP cases that meet federal work participation requirement.**

The current percentage of FIP cases that meet federal work participation requirements for FY 2013, year-to-date (October 2012-November 2012) is **48.8%**. This percentage is calculated by the DHS Office of Quality Assurance.

The DHS Office of Quality Assurance reports work participation rates (WPR) on a 3 month lag because of the rigorous methodology and testing required to calculate the data for federal reporting purposes.
