
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This case originated as an enforcement action by the Department of Insurance and Financial Services alleging the Respondents, in selling automobile insurance, violated various provisions of the Michigan Insurance Code. The Respondents' insurance licenses were summarily suspended on August 22, 2013 and a hearing was scheduled to adjudicate the matter. On September 6, 2013, the licenses were reinstated by order of the Ingham County Circuit Court.

The parties, in an agreement filed September 24, 2013, have now agreed that the hearing should be dismissed without prejudice and that an enforcement case may proceed with the Respondents afforded an opportunity to show compliance as provided in section 92(1) of the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, MCL 24.292(1). In a Stipulation and Order for Settlement and Dismissal of Lawsuit dated September 11, 2013, the parties have resolved their related civil litigation. An Ingham County Circuit Court order of the same date acknowledged the stipulation and, among its provisions, ordered that:

The Pending Administrative Hearing will proceed as an enforcement action under the procedures outlined in MCL 500.1244 that provide Defendants [sic] with an opportunity for hearing prior to the entry of any order imposing the sanctions described in that statute.

Based on the foregoing, it is ORDERED that the present contested case hearing be dismissed without prejudice.
