

SUBJECT: Report Required by MCL 492.106a

Section 492.106a of the Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act requires a report by December 1st of each year that contains the following information:

- (a) The number of initial and renewal applications received and completed within the 90-day time period described in subsection (1);
- (b) The number of applications denied; and
- (c) The number of applicants not issued a license within the 90-day time period and the amount of money returned to licensees and registrants under subsection (3).

Attached is the DIFS report of that information for the period October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act Annual Report Required by MCL 492.106a(4) Report Period October 1, 2015 - September 30, 2016

Receipt of completed application for new or renewal license; issuance of license within certain time period; report.

Pursuant to Section 6a(4) of the Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act (Act), the Director of the Department of Insurance and Financial Services (DIFS) shall submit a report by December 1 of each year to the standing committees of the senate and house of representatives concerned with commerce issues and to the appropriations subcommittees of the senate and house of representatives generally responsible for appropriations to DIFS.

The Director reports the following as required by Section 6a(4) of the Act for fiscal year 2016:

(a) The number of initial and renewal applications the administrator received and completed within the 90-day time period described in subsection (1).

- Installment Seller licenses: 2105
- Sales Finance licenses: 665
- Total 2770

(b) The number of applications denied.

- Installment Seller licenses: *1
- Sales Finance licenses: 0

(c) The number of applicants not issued a license within the 90-day time period and the amount of money returned to licensees and registrants under subsection (3).

- Installment Seller licenses: (\$30) *1
- Sales Finance licenses: 0

*No new applications were denied in fiscal year 2016. One installment seller application denied in fiscal year 2015 was appealed by the applicant. A final decision was issued in fiscal year 2016, upholding the denial.
