Affirmative Insurance Company of Michigan Rehabilitation Information

On October 29, 2015 Ingham County Circuit Court Judge Clinton Canady III issued a Rehabilitation Order placing Affirmative Insurance Company of Michigan (“Affirmative”) into Rehabilitation and naming the Director of the Department of Insurance and Financial Services (“DIFS”) as the company’s Rehabilitator. Rehabilitation is a corporate reorganization under Chapter 81 of the Michigan Insurance Code that is conducted under the supervision of the Ingham County Circuit Court. The Rehabilitation Order allows DIFS to ascertain Affirmative’s financial condition and implement steps to protect Affirmative’s policyholders and creditors.

The Director of DIFS has appointed James Gerber as Deputy Rehabilitator. If you are an insured of Affirmative and need information, please call Affirmative’s customer service at 1-(972)-728-9814. Policyholders/Providers:

Until further notice, all covered claims will be reported and paid in the ordinary course of business. At this time, all covered claims are being paid at 100% of the authorized settlement or payment.
