

**AMENDED ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION TO DISMISS**

On January 11, 2019, an order was entered Granting Petitioners' Motion to Dismiss.

On February 7, 2019, Respondent filed a Motion to Amend Order Granting Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss in DIFS CASE NUMBER 15-963-1 (MAHS DOCKET No. 15-040103) AND CASE NUMBER 16-9771-1 (MAHS DOCKET NO. 16-013298), which dismissed the matter without prejudice.
