



Effective today, June 18, 2019, perpetual individual and company MLO surety bonds will be **required**. All bonds currently on file with our office will need to be converted to a perpetual bond, without expiration, by December 31, 2019 regardless of their current expiration date. A new, original bond must be mailed to our office (an electronic copy will not suffice). Please mail your signed, original bond to one of the mailing addresses below. **Failure to complete the conversion to a perpetual bond will affect an MLO's ability to renew their license for 2020.**
