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JUDGMENT AGAINST PROVIDENCE PARK HOSPITAL

PRESENT: HONORABLE JAMES S. JAMO, CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS, Anita G. Fox, Director of the Michigan Department of Insurance and Financial Services (“DIFS”) and duly appointed Liquidator of Consumers Mutual Insurance of Michigan (the “Liquidator”),¹ filed a *Notice of Hearing to Request Entry of Judgment against Providence Park Hospital*, together with Exhibits A – C and the Proof of Service (the “Notice of Hearing”), on April 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Hearing scheduled a hearing in the sub-captioned matter above (*In Re: Consumers Mutual Insurance of Michigan v Providence Park Hospital*, Provider Petition No. 7) on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 3:15 p.m., before the Honorable James S. Jamo in the Veterans Memorial Courthouse, 313 W. Kalamazoo Street, Lansing, Michigan 48933, for the purpose of the Liquidator requesting entry of Judgment against Providence Park Hospital (“Providence”) in the amount of \$8,163.08; and

WHEREAS, as reflected by the Proof of Service, the Notice of Hearing was served on Providence on April 12, 2019 via U.S. First Class Mail addressed to both the Resident Agent for Providence and the last-known address of the Providence billing and payment department; and

WHEREAS, prior to serving the Notice of Hearing on April 12, 2019, the Liquidator served on Providence: (a) the *Petition for Establishment of Court Procedures to Adjudicate Liquidator’s Claims against Providence Park Hospital* (the

“Petition”), which was re-attached as Exhibit A to the Notice of Hearing and was initially served on Providence on December 5, 2018; and (b) the corresponding *Order Granting Petition for Establishment of Court Procedures to Adjudicate Liquidator’s Claims against Providence Park Hospital* (the “Order”), which was re-attached as Exhibit B to the Notice of Hearing and was initially served on Providence on December 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Providence has not responded in any manner to the Notice of Hearing, the Petition, or the Order; and

WHEREAS, Providence is not an infant or incompetent person, nor is Providence in the military service; and

WHEREAS, the Court having reviewed the Notice of Hearing, the Petition, and the Order; having received evidence in support of the Notice of Hearing on May 22, 2019; and the Court being otherwise fully advised of the circumstances involving Consumers Mutual and its ongoing receivership proceeding, which was commenced on November 13, 2015, assigned to this Court, and has been conducted under the Court’s general supervision;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Judgment is entered in favor of Consumers Mutual Insurance of Michigan against Providence Park Hospital in the amount of \$8,163.08.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that barring Providence Park Hospital’s timely payment of this Judgment within thirty (30) days after entry, the Liquidator may request the Court to impose an additional fine not exceeding \$10,000 due to

Providence obstructing and/or interfering with this Consumers Mutual liquidation proceeding, pursuant to MCL 500.8106 and Paragraph 15 of the Order of Liquidation and Declaration of Insolvency of Consumers Mutual that the Court entered on February 10, 2016.

IT IS SO ORDERED AND ADJUDGED.
