AMENDED ORDER OF SUSPENSION

1. Whereas, the Chief Deputy Commissioner of the Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation pursuant to the authority granted under the Michigan Insurance Code (Code), MCL 500.100 *et seq.*, initiated an investigation of Respondent; and
2. Whereas, on the basis of that investigation, the Chief Deputy Commissioner concluded that Respondent violated the Code by engaging in violations of MCL 500.1207 and MCL 500.1239; and
3. Whereas, on January 6, 2012, the Chief Deputy Commissioner issued to Respondent a Notice of Opportunity to Show Compliance; and
4. Whereas, on October 1, 2012, Respondent agreed to enter into a Settlement Agreement for Temporary Limitation of Respondent's Insurance Producer License (Agreement); and
5. Whereas, pursuant to the Agreement, Respondent's insurance producer license was limited from October 5, 2012, through January 3, 2013; and
6. Whereas, Respondent agreed and understood that if he failed to request that the Commissioner lift the Temporary Limitation of Respondent's Insurance Producer License within 30 days after January 3, 2013, the Commissioner would suspend his insurance producer license; and
7. Whereas, Respondent also waived his right to further administrative hearings or proceedings prior to the suspension of his insurance producer license;

8. Whereas, Respondent failed to file a request with the Commissioner to lift the Temporary Limitation of his insurance producer license.
9. Whereas, a previously entered Order of Suspension contained an erroneous system identification number necessitating this amended Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Chief Deputy Commissioner finds and orders:

1. Respondent failed to file, within 30 days after January 3, 2013, a request to the Chief Deputy Commissioner to lift the Temporary Limitation of Respondent's Insurance Producer License. Consequently, Respondent failed to comply with the Settlement Agreement for Temporary Limitation of Respondent's Insurance Producer License.
2. Respondent agreed that in the event he failed to comply with the requirements of the Settlement Agreement for Temporary Limitation of Respondent's Insurance Producer License, his insurance producer license would be immediately suspended.
3. Respondent's insurance producer license is hereby immediately suspended.
4. Respondent shall immediately refrain from selling, soliciting or negotiating insurance in the State of Michigan.
