WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS ON THE JOB?

By law, you are entitled to:

- X** A safe and healthful workplace.
- X** Protective equipment provided by your employer, when needed, like safety glasses, gloves and aprons.
- X** Training on the hazards of the job and how to protect yourself.
- X** Payment for medical care if you get hurt or sick on the job. You may be entitled to lost wages.
- X** A legal minimum wage - as defined by your age.
- X** Report serious safety problems to MIOSHA.
