POLICY 0410 Motor Vehicles

Issued: January 6, 1997
Reviewed: June 21, 2012

Executive Branch Departments, Sub-units, and other state operations that utilize state motor vehicle services provided by the Department of Technology, Management and Budget, Vehicle and Travel Services shall comply with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements concerning acquisition, assignment, maintenance, operation and disposal of state motor vehicles, and use of state motor vehicles and privately owned vehicles on official state business. All other state operations, including, but not limited to, the Michigan Department of Transportation, state colleges and universities, and the Judicial and Legislative branches, which utilize state motor vehicles shall comply with all defined procedures. In addition, state employees who drive commercial motor vehicles must comply with applicable statutory and regulatory provisions, promulgated by the Michigan State Police, as required by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
