

1710.22 Environmental Permit Coordination

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PURPOSE

To assure that all projects are conducted under the authority of proper environmental permits (or approvals of a permit-like nature) to prevent impacts to public health or the environment in accordance with environmental law and to ensure that personnel obtain required certifications necessary to competently manage environmental operations.

APPLICATION

Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units.

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SUMMARY

The following laws require projects or activities be conducted in accordance with a permit from the Department of Environmental Quality or require persons to be certified or otherwise licenses to perform various duties:

Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, PA 138 of 1998, as amended.

Land Division Act, PA 28 of 1967, as amended.

Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, PA 451 of 1994, as amended.

Public Health Code, PA 368 of 1978, as amended.

Safe Drinking Water Act, PA 399 of 1976, as amended.

The Mobile Home Commission Act, PA 96 of 1987, as amended.
