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Vehicles and heavy equipment to be offered at June 14 surplus auction

LANSING – Cars, vans, SUVs, trucks, trailers of all sizes, and a variety of heavy equipment will be among some items offered at a Department of Management and Budget surplus auction on Saturday, June 14, at 731 N. Canal, Lansing. Prospective buyers may examine items Friday, June 13, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Saturday from 8 to 9:30 a.m. The auction begins at 10 a.m.

The bid list includes GMC, Dodge and Ford pickup trucks and SUVs and Cavalier, Taurus, Monte Carlo, Jeep Cherokee and Crown Victoria automobiles. Equipment such as forklifts, front-end loaders, brush hog mowers, truck toppers, trailers, a compressor, a snow plow, a snow blower and a flatbed truck will also be offered.

Successful bidders must pay at the time of purchase using cash, MasterCard, Visa, Discover, in-state checks or money orders made payable to the State of Michigan.
