DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Veterans Home Chesterfield Township, Michigan

The Michigan Veterans Affairs Agency (MVAA) announces the preparation and availability of a “Draft Environmental Assessment” (DEA) for the proposed construction and operation associated with the new MVAA Senior Living home, which would be located at the Seville Manor site, which is a currently-vacant property on Sugarbush Road across from Dean A. Naldrett School.

Comments are encouraged from veterans, stakeholders, government agencies, and members of the public.

This project is funded through a U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs State Home Grant Program. The DEA has been prepared in accordance with the regulations for implementing the procedural provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), (Public Law 91-190, 42 USC 4321-4347 January 1, 1970), amendments, and VA's Implementing Regulations (38 CFR Part 26).

MVAA intends to issue a “Finding of No Significant Impact” (FONSI) following a thirty day comment period in accordance with the Council on Environmental Quality Regulations for Implementing NEPA, Section 1508.13 providing there are no substantive comments which warrant further evaluation.
