- The State Education Office will verify on the application form that you qualify for the grant and forward the completed application to the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships at Cleary University.

Scholarships for Veterans

100% Undergraduate / 50% Graduate Military Service Grant

This grant is available to current active military or honorably discharged veterans for out-of-pocket tuition costs up to 12 credits per term after all other grants, scholarships, employer reimbursement, or VA benefits have been applied.

- Students are required to annually complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid and accept any grants and/or scholarships for which they may be eligible.
- Honorably discharged veterans are required to provide a copy of their DD214 (Member Copy 4 Preferred).
- Students can use the current generic scholarship application to apply and submit to the financial aid office. Essay requirement waived.
- Students are required to maintain at least a 2.0 GPA undergraduate, 3.0 GPA graduate and successfully complete classes to maintain eligibility.
- Graduate military grant must be used within 10 years from discharge date.
