Subject: Notice of Estimated Payments in Lieu of Taxes
DNR Land Transaction #20090157

In accordance with Public Act Numbers 240 and 294 of 2012, this notice is being provided to you as the Treasurer of the local taxing unit where the Department of Natural Resources is acquiring new public land. These Public Acts require the Department to estimate the amount of annual payments in lieu of taxes (PILT) on public lands that it is acquiring, and to provide that information to you at least 30 days before the acquisition. Please note that these are only estimates. The Department does not have the authority to determine the valuation of real property for the purposes of the annual PILT payments. Per MCL 324.2153 this authority lies with the State Tax Commission.

The following is a breakdown of the Department's estimate of annual PILT payments for public lands where Act 451 of 1994, Part 21, Subpart 14 directs the State to make these payments and for those lands where Subpart 13 directs the payment of taxes on tax reverted, recreation, and forest lands that are not covered under Subpart 14.

Subpart 13 – Estimated tax on tax reverted, recreation, and forest lands: \$0.00.

Subpart 14 - Estimated Annual PILT Payments: \$200.00.

Also, for your information I have attached a copy of a memo that summarizes this acquisition of public land within your jurisdiction.

Authority: Part 21 of Act 451, Public Acts of 1994, as amended

Notice: This item will appear on the Department of Natural Resources and Environment's (Department) February 22, 2010 Calendar, and is eligible for approval on March 1, 2010.

Comments: The offered and desired easements are located in Marquette County, at Winthrop Junction, southwest of downtown Ishpeming, along portions of the former Duluth, South Shore and Atlantic Railway's Second Subdivision Main Line, and the former Chicago & North Western Railway's Loop Line.

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The exchange will enable continued use of the active railroad for material shipment, while accommodating the safe use of the trail through the Winthrop Junction site. With this transaction, the Department will obtain a permanent recreational trail easement that extends the route of the Ishpeming to Humboldt Trail, 1,120 feet into the City of Ishpeming. The Department will also reserve a trail crossing over the easement desired by the applicant.

Acquired in 2003, development of the Ishpeming to Humboldt Trail has been hindered due to the lack of a connector trail into the City of Ishpeming. This exchange resolves that shortcoming, and as a designated segment of the route for the locally proposed Iron Ore Heritage Trail (IOHT), will help stimulate the completion of other trail projects along the proposed route. The IOHT is envisioned as a 48-mile, multi-use, year round trail that connects, preserves, and interprets the significant sites, structures, and stories of Marquette County's iron mining heritage.

This transaction for the proposed easement exchange was reviewed by Department staff, and recommended for approval by the Land Exchange Review Committee on December 17, 2009.


- Recommendations:
- (1) That this exchange of easements be approved.
 - (2) That the Department reserve a trail crossing over the desired easement.
 - (3) That the offered easement be put to use as a Michigan Trailway and designated as such when the legislated requirements are met, pursuant to Part 721 of Act 451, Public Acts of 1994, as amended.

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(4) That the offered easement be dedicated for public use and administered by the Forest Management Division.







OFFERED EASEMENT

A strip of land being twenty Five (25) feet in width located in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 16, T47N, R27W, City of Ishpeming, Marquette County, Michigan described as follows: Commencing at the N ¼ Corner of said Section 16; thence N89°56'25"E 673.56 feet (along the North Line of said NE-NW, to the C/L of the Pepin Ireco Railroad) and the Point of Beginning; thence Southerly (along said C/L) on an irregular curve to the right 1120 feet more or less (to the C/L of Washington Street) and the Point of Ending, being S5°07'10"E 845.21 feet from the Point of Commencing. Said parcel contains 0.64 acres more or less.

And;

A strip of land being Eight (8) feet in width, lying southerly of, adjacent to, and parallel with the following described line, located in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 16, T47N, R27W, City of Ishpeming, Marquette County, Michigan; said line described as follows: Commencing at the N ¼ Corner of Said Section 16; thence S5°10'48"E 823.98 feet (to the C/L of Washington Street, and the South R/W of old DSS&A Railroad) and the Point of Beginning; thence (along said R/W the next two bearings), S76°06'55"W 73.20 feet; thence S78°12'54"W 195.27; thence N60°00'00"W 11.88 feet, (to the point of ending where the southerly 8' line meets the South R/W of the old DSS&A Railroad. Said parcel contains 0.05 acres more or less.


DESIRED EASEMENT

A strip of land being Fifteen (15) feet in width, (7.5 feet each side of and adjacent to the following described line), located in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼, and the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 16, T47N, R27W, City of Ishpeming, Marquette County, Michigan; said Center line described as follows: Commencing at the N ¼ Corner of Said Section 16; thence S5°20'18"E 773.12 feet (to the C/L Washington Street, and the C/L of old DSS&A Railroad) being the Point of Beginning; thence (along said C/L the next two Bearings), S76°06'55"W 80.72 feet; thence on a 5° curve to the left (R=955.00', D=17°26'02", L.C. bears S68°289.47 feet) 290.59 feet along the Arc, (to the point of ending on the South R/W of the old DSS&A Railroad. Said parcel is encumbered by a 25' DNRE Trail Crossing, and contains 0.21 acres.
