

2015 AHGP Funded Projects

Milliken State Park Pocket Marsh with River Connection (\$200,000)

DNR-Parks and Recreation Division, Wayne County



Creation of a naturalized area of nearshore, protected, shallow water habitat and shoreline with direct connection to the Detroit River main channel. This improved habitat includes the installation of woody material for improved shoreline fish habitat.

Bridging the Jordan River Restoration (\$200,000)

Conservation Resource Alliance, Antrim County



Replacement of an undersized twin culvert at Old State Road with a full span concrete bridge to allow unrestricted connectivity for aquatic species.

Cedar Creek Aquatic Habitat Restoration (\$305,800)

Barry County Conservation District, Barry County



Replacement of undersized culvert with a full span timber bridge opening up 39 stream miles and restoring connectivity with the Thornapple River for aquatic species.

Free Span the Maple River Connectivity Initiative – Phase II (\$430,168.00)

Conservation Resource Alliance, Emmet County



Removal of the Lake Kathleen/Maple River dam and replacement of undersized culverts in two locations with free spanning timber bridges resulting in the connectivity of over 50 miles of streams and two inland lakes.

Lime Lake Restoration (\$48,220)

Jackson County Parks Department, Jackson County



Repair a breach that has eroded between South Lime Lake and Third Lake ultimately restoring the historic flow pattern and re-establishing groundwater elevations within the Lime Lake Fen.

Boardman River Dam Removal Monitoring (\$65,812)

Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians, Grant Traverse County



Monitoring, evaluation and post dam removal data collection work related to the removal of the Boardman and Sabin Dams on the Boardman River.
