8:00 am Twin Lakes State Park Enjoy coffee and treats with MI-TRALE in the shelter at Twin Lakes State Park, then join us for an ORV ride from Twin Lakes to Bergland at 9:00am! Upon arriving, food and drinks will be available. After lunch, enjoy many scenic sites in the Bergland area. Riders are free to ride back at their own pace and explore over 300 miles of local designated trails.



9:00 am – 12: 30 pm Bewabic State Park Join the DNR and Chippewa Sno-Kats in the first annual Bewabic State Park Off-Road Trek (S.P.O.R.T.) ORV ride! Meet at the Chippewa Sno-Kats Quonset Hut at 9:00 am and hit the trails! The ride will end at Bewabic State Park, which is now open for ORV use on park roads. Food will be provided at the park's day use area; riders return to Crystal Falls on their own and are encouraged to enjoy the park and local riding opportunities, like the Stateline Trail.



9:00 am – 12:00 pm Muskallonge Lake State Park Join the DNR along with S.O.R.V.A. (Snowmobile & O.R.V. Association of Alger County) for a guided ride from Muskallonge State Park to Paradise! Meet at 9:00 am in the day use area and hit the trails at 9:30 am. Lunch and refreshments will be on your own, then return to Muskallonge State Park.
