State Qualifying Events:

Schools/Coaches may choose to have their invitational count as a State Qualifying Event (IT MUST BE REGISTERED AS SUCH ON NASP WEBSITE AND USE THE NASP SITE FOR REGISTRATION AND FOR SCORING - \$1/archer)

Schools MUST shoot at a State Qualifying Event in order to compete at States. (HOST SCHOOLS GET TO HAVE THEIR TEAMS REGISTER FIRST AT THEIR STATE QUALIFYING EVENT – this is due to them doing all the work and their parent volunteers are there to help AND see their child shoot. If we do not allow this teams will have a hard time getting parent volunteers to help at their event. When you set up the event as the administrator, the NASP system allows you to select your flight times as soon as the event is approved by NASP, so you do not need to wait for “registration to open” like all guest teams.)

Teams may shoot in as many State Qualifiers as they choose in order to improve their scores so they may get a better Tier time for registration at States.

If these events fill up and a team feels like they cannot get into a State Qualifying Event, all they have to do is host an event and their team gets to register for this event first, guaranteeing them a chance to shoot a qualifying score.

Registration for a State Qualifier will be done like this (and it will NEED TO BE ON THE HONOR SYSTEM). I ask that hosting schools watch their registrations to see if a pre-qualified school registers early. If they do you will need to contact the coach and ask them to remove their archers until the following day.

1. Host school Registers when they post event (early registration for hosting school only).
2. All NON-Qualified Teams Register on Day One of Event Registration.
3. All teams that have already qualified for States at a previous state qualifier can then register on day two (24 hours later – 7AM opens on day one, you wait till 7AM on day two).
4. Then Registration stays open until flights are all full.

Example Using Hartland’s State Qualifier this year on Feb. 15th: Registration Opens for HARTLAND ARCHERS once event is created (as they are the hosting school). All NON-QUALIFIED TEAMS register Feb. 9th at 9:00AM (one day after Swartz Creek’s Qualifying event, so team know if they need to wait 24 hours or not) 24 hours later on Feb. 10th at 9:00AM ANYONE MAY REGISTER, even teams that have already qualified for States. Registration closes on Feb. 12th.

Mar. 8 (5PM EST) DROP BY DATE/TIME...deadline to drop flight positions. You are responsible to pay registration for all flight positions you have registered at this time.

Mar. 8 (9PM EST) – Registration Closes

1. **PAYEMENTS MADE OUT TO “NASP” and sent to address on invoice you MUST print out agreeing to pay. PayPal THE BEST option. All payments must be received by MARCH 18th!**

Every archer and/or team is **NOT guaranteed** a spot at States. When flights are full the tournament closes.

MI State Event will Follow NASP 2020 National Rules for this event.

Michigan State Virtual 3D Event

MI State Event will Follow NASP IBO 2020 National Rules for this event.

This we have at least four schools hosting a State Virtual Scoring/National Qualifier Event.

Due to having more than one National Qualifier - we cannot identify on the NASP site who the State Champions are at each division. Why does this matter? At these National Qualifying Events your school may shoot a qualifying score for Nationals, but due to NASP not being able to identify a "State Champion" all qualified archers would be bumped down to Tiers 4, 5, and 6 (below the top three tiers, which are tiers saved for states which have an identified champion at each level.)

So - in order to recognize the best HS, MS and ES team for 3D in MI we set up a "MI State Virtual Event". This worked well last year, and we plan to repeat this option again this year. (It is our hope to add a LIVE 3D State Tournament in a year or two.) All you need to do is register the team(s) you wish from the National Qualifier where your team shot the best. This score will be compared to the other schools who have entered their best event scores. If your team shoots the highest score, then they will have a better tier for Nationals. (Or if you have any archers in their division who finish in the Top 10!)

Do you have to do the Virtual event - NO!! It is simply a way for NASP to verify who are the top archers and top teams so they can register for Nationals sooner than Tiers 4, 5, and 6. What is the cost of the virtual event for your archers? The payment is all done on line, as there is no live event to pay at - so using PayPal it is \$1.25 per archer and NASP will tally all scores.

What do you do?

You register your archers AND enter their 3D scores!

You must select **ONE of the National Qualifiers** you shot at and you **MUST use all archer scores from this ONE event**. You cannot create a "false team score" by using some scores from one National Qualifier and then other scores from a different National Qualifier. Again, this event is simply done to allow coaches a better chance of getting the flight times they need at Nationals.

Just because a team shoots a qualifying score **DOES NOT** guarantee them a flight time at Nationals - if the flight fills up prior to your tier - then you will not shoot.

To be considered a National Qualifier the range must meet NASP regulations, the correct targets must be used and there MUST be at least two schools shooting against each other – from a DIFFERENT district.
