**Experience:** Beginner

**Gear:** Participants should be dressed to be comfortable outdoors for the day. Please bring eye and ear protection, if possible.

Bring water and anything else you will need to stay healthy and comfortable for 4-6hours. If unvaccinated, please bring a mask for indoor portions of the class.

Please **do not** bring your own firearms or ammunition for the class, these will be provided for you (This does not apply to pistols carried under the authority of a concealed pistol license or properly carried under authority of a specific exemption from the requirement of a concealed pistol license.)

Speed limit inside the club grounds is 15MPH. Parking is available at the Club house. Restrooms and a fridge and microwave are also located at the club house.

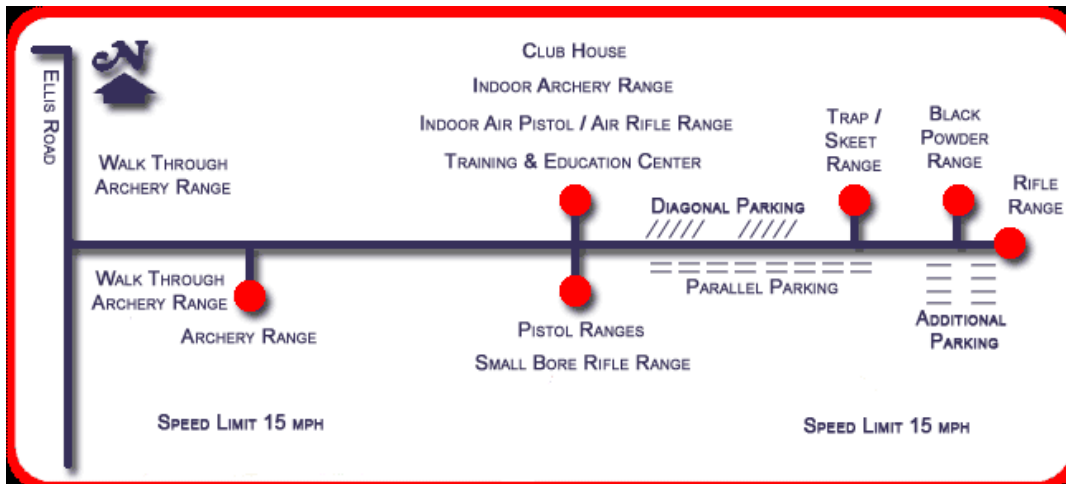
**Address & Directions:** 5095 Ellis Rd, Ypsilanti Township, MI 48197

Traveling east on I-94, take Exit 181 to US 12 West (Michigan Avenue).

Traveling west on I-94, take Exit 181A to US 12 West.

Ellis Road is the first road left off Michigan Ave. It makes two sharp turns before heading directly south about a mile to the WSC. As the pavement ends, turn left to the WSC entrance, 5095 Ellis Road. Follow road 1/4 mile to the main clubhouse on the left.

### About the Classes:

This is the Hunter Safety Education course needed to purchase a hunting license in Michigan. This class is intended for women 14 years or older. The class will run from 8:00am – 12:00pm, starting promptly at 8:00am.

The hunter education field day course is an alternative to the traditional course. This is the same as the traditional hunter education course; however, the classroom portion is completed online.

After students complete the course online, they must attend and complete the field day to earn a hunter safety certificate.

Students choosing the online course followed by the field day must present a copy of their certificate of completion (voucher) of the online course at the start of the field day. The online course is fee based and can be taken at [hunter-ed.com/michigan/](http://hunter-ed.com/michigan/).

Michigan's hunter education course is taught by a dedicated core of certified volunteer instructors and Michigan conservation officers.

About the field day:

- In person field day
- 4 hours minimum
- Written test (80% or better to pass) and practice assessment (pass/fail)
- Minimum age of 14
