Part of the Easterly 80 feet of the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, lying North of the West Branch Sturgeon River and Southerly of the centerline of the county road, as more accurately described in the

case file.

PA 240 of 2018: This parcel is north of the Mason-Arenac county line and will result in

a decrease of 0.26-acre of DNR-managed lands.

Applicant(s): Debora Murray, Wolverine, Michigan

Authority: Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451,

as amended.

Acquired: By exchange for tax reverted land in 1965.

Minerals: Mineral rights will be conveyed.

Comments: The desired parcel is a small parcel of land adjacent to private

ownership. There is a drainfield, shed and other minor improvements that were placed on this parcel by the previous landowners. The sale

of this parcel will resolve a structural trespass.

The proposed land disposal was recommended for approval as

surplus by the Land Exchange Review Committee on

December 17, 2019.

Proceeds will be deposited into the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF). The LEFF allows the Department to sell rights in land and

deposit the proceeds in a fund which can then be used to acquire replacement property.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the land be sold to the applicant for \$5,800.00.
- 2. That the proceeds of the sale be deposited in the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF).
- 3. That the state retain aboriginal antiquities.
