- Stand 28: Winter cut only in campground. Slash to be chipped in this portion also, or removed. Can cut December 1-February 1.
- Stand 30: Can cut October 1-February 1. Check prior to harvest for nesting.
- Stand 37: Can cut August 1-February 1. Check prior to harvest for nesting.
- Logger to post signs.
- Sale to be done ASAP to begin December 1 this year, or next year for sure.


