

**FO – 239.09**

**HURON RIVER NO-KILL BASS REGULATION**

Under the authority of sections 41101 through 41105 of Act 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as amended, being sections 324.41101 through 324.41105 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the Director of the Department of Natural Resources on October 9, 2008, ordered that for a period of five years it shall be unlawful to possess any largemouth or smallmouth bass and any that are caught must be released immediately, in the area of the Huron River, Washtenaw County, starting at the Mast Road Bridge in the Village of Dexter (Sec. 32, T1S, R5E) downstream to the Delhi Road Bridge (Sec. 2, T2S, R5E).

This order is assigned number FO-239.09 and is titled “Huron River No-Kill Bass Regulations.”

This order supersedes the order entitled “Huron River No-Kill Bass Regulations” effective April 1, 2004, and assigned number FO-239.04.

This order shall take effect on April 1, 2009, and shall remain effective through March 31, 2014
