



FOREST STEWARDSHIP PLAN WRITER
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Required under the Forestry Title of the 1990 Federal Farm Bill to become a certified plan writer under the Forest Stewardship Program.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be valid for three years from the date of the Forest Stewardship Coordinator's signature. This MOU is entered into between the DNR Forest Resources Division and the following Forest Stewardship Plan Writer:

Both parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be cancelled by either party by written notice to the Resource Professional (and employer, if applicable) or DNR Forest Resources Division. Cancellation will become effective thirty (30) days after said notice is given.
