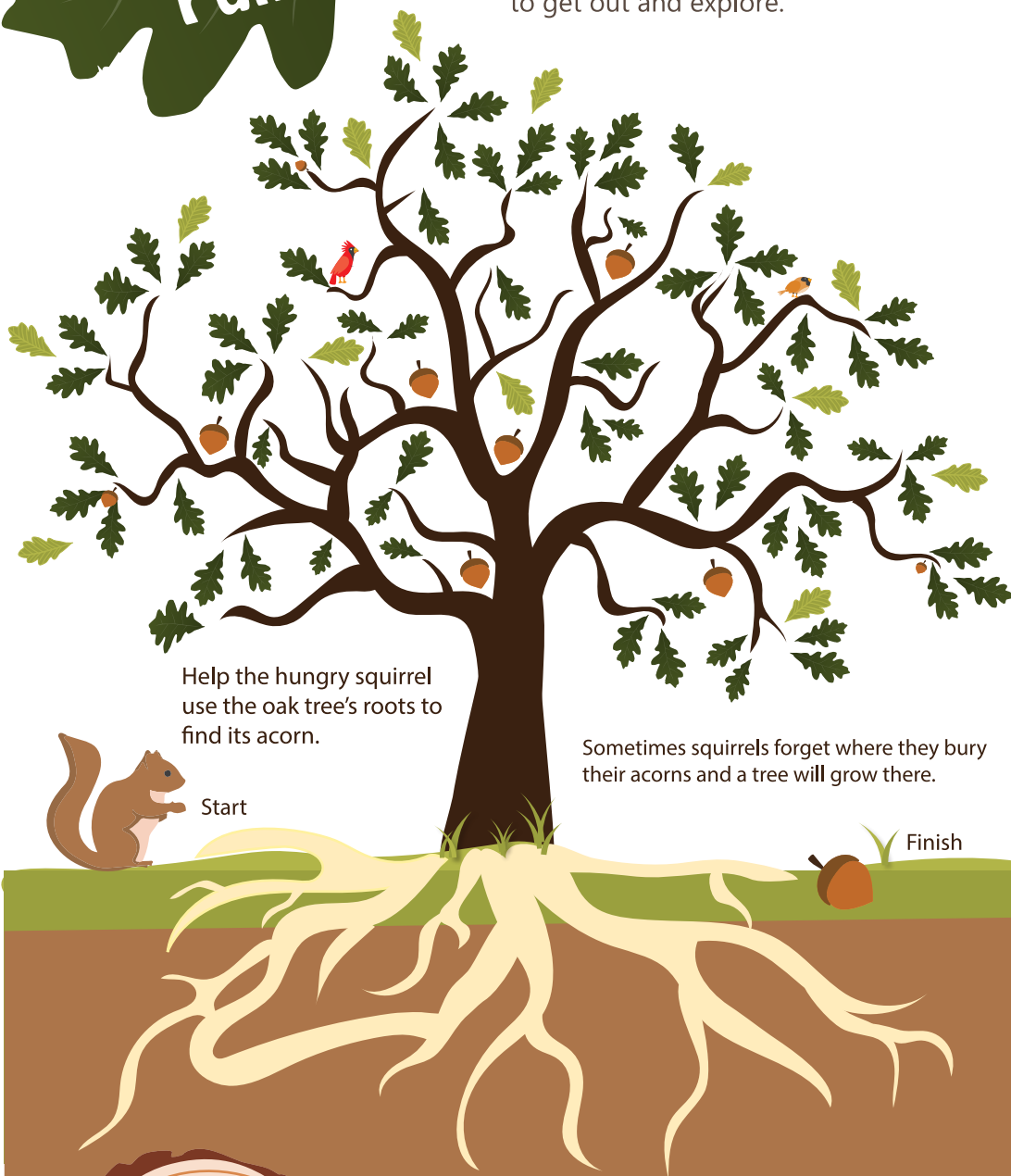


Forestry Fun!
