Notes:

- *Proposal assumes 7% decline in license sales due to resistance to license fee changes.
- *Proposal retains senior discounts at 60% for the following licenses: base, deer, fur harvester, fall turkey, spring turkey, and fish all-species.
- *Proposal includes an apprentice option when purchasing a base license.
- *Proposal does not include 15% multi-license discount.
- *Proposal would require that all replacement licenses are charged at the same price as the original licenses.
- *Current lifetime hunting and fishing license holders would continue to receive the same privileges that they currently receive.
- *FY14 Executive Budget does not reflect full annual revenue as the proposed license changes would not take effect until March 1, 2014.
- ^A \$1 surcharge would be added to only the indicated license types. The generated revenue would be dedicated for marketing, education, and outreach activities.
