OFF-ROAD VEHICLE SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND INSTRUCTIONS

Required under the authority of Part 811, 1994 PA 451, as amended, to be eligible for grant funding.

General Information

- 1. The Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) Safety Education Program is administered by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Parks and Recreation Division (PRD) and Law Enforcement Division (LED).
- 2. Grant payment for safety instruction through the ORV Safety Education Program is based on a flat rate of \$15 per student. The amount awarded to each grantee is based on the amount requested, the funding available, and may include consideration of past performance regarding number of students actually taught each year. No additional grant funding will be made available for equipment purchases, overhead costs, travel, or other expenses.

Grant Application

1. Complete the *ORV Safety Education Program Grant Application (PR1831).* Provide name, address, and Federal Identification Number of the grant applicant agency or organization. Provide the name, phone number and e-mail address of the contact person for the agency or organization.

Eligible grant applicants for the ORV Safety Education Program are:

- Colleges, universities, local education agencies, intermediate school districts and regional educational service agencies in the State of Michigan;
- Local government agencies in the State of Michigan.
- List all certified instructors that will be teaching the ORV classes for this organization or agency. For questions regarding instructor certification, contact the Department's Law Enforcement Division at DNR-LED-RecSafety@Michigan.gov or visit the Volunteer Recreation Safety web page.
- 3. Indicate the estimated number of students to be taught by each instructor. Provide the location and dates, if known. Attach additional sheets if necessary.
- 4. Obtain the appropriate signature for the grant applicant agency, certifying the accuracy of the information provided on the ORV Safety Education Program Grant Application (PR1831).

Requesting Grant Payment

Request for payment can be submitted to the Department at any time during the grant year after classes have been conducted. Up to two (2) payments per grant year will be made based on a flat rate of **\$15 per student taught**. The final request for payment is due no later than **October 1** following the end of the grant year. No advance payments will be made.

On the *Grant Payment Request* form (PR1831-1) indicate whether the request is for partial or final payment. Indicate the total number of students instructed and the dollar amount requested for payment.
