Comments: The desired parcels were requested by the Macatawa Park Cottagers

(subdivision) Association to provide water abatement protection and water access to the association. As part of the application process, the association agreed that Lots 405, 406, 407 and 408 could be sold directly to the Christine L. Visner Trust. The Trust has agreement

with the other abutting owners to purchase these lots.

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The proposed land disposal was recommended for approval as surplus by the Land Exchange Review Committee on October 17, 2019.

Proceeds will be deposited into the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF). The LEFF allows the Department to sell rights in land and deposit the proceeds in a fund which can then be used to acquire replacement property.

Recommendations:

- 1. That the land be sold to the applicants for \$259,000.00.
- 2. That the proceeds of the sale be deposited in the LEFF.
- 3. That the state retain aboriginal antiquities rights.


