# Muskegon and Rogue River State Game Areas

- Prior LUOD restricting target shooting in certain areas.
- High use has expanded to other parts of game areas.
- Consistent disregard for rules.
- DNR wants to limit safety concerns as well as damage to game areas from expanded target shooting.







It is unlawful to target shoot at  
any object other than paper,  
cardboard, clay, or a commercially  
or privately produced target  
designed and manufactured for  
the specific purpose of target  
shooting. It is unlawful to target  
shoot at any explosive  
or incendiary target.

Target shooting is allowed on the  
Rogue River Game Area north of M-46.  
To keep this privilege, do not  
Use sufficient backstops and  
remove all litter.







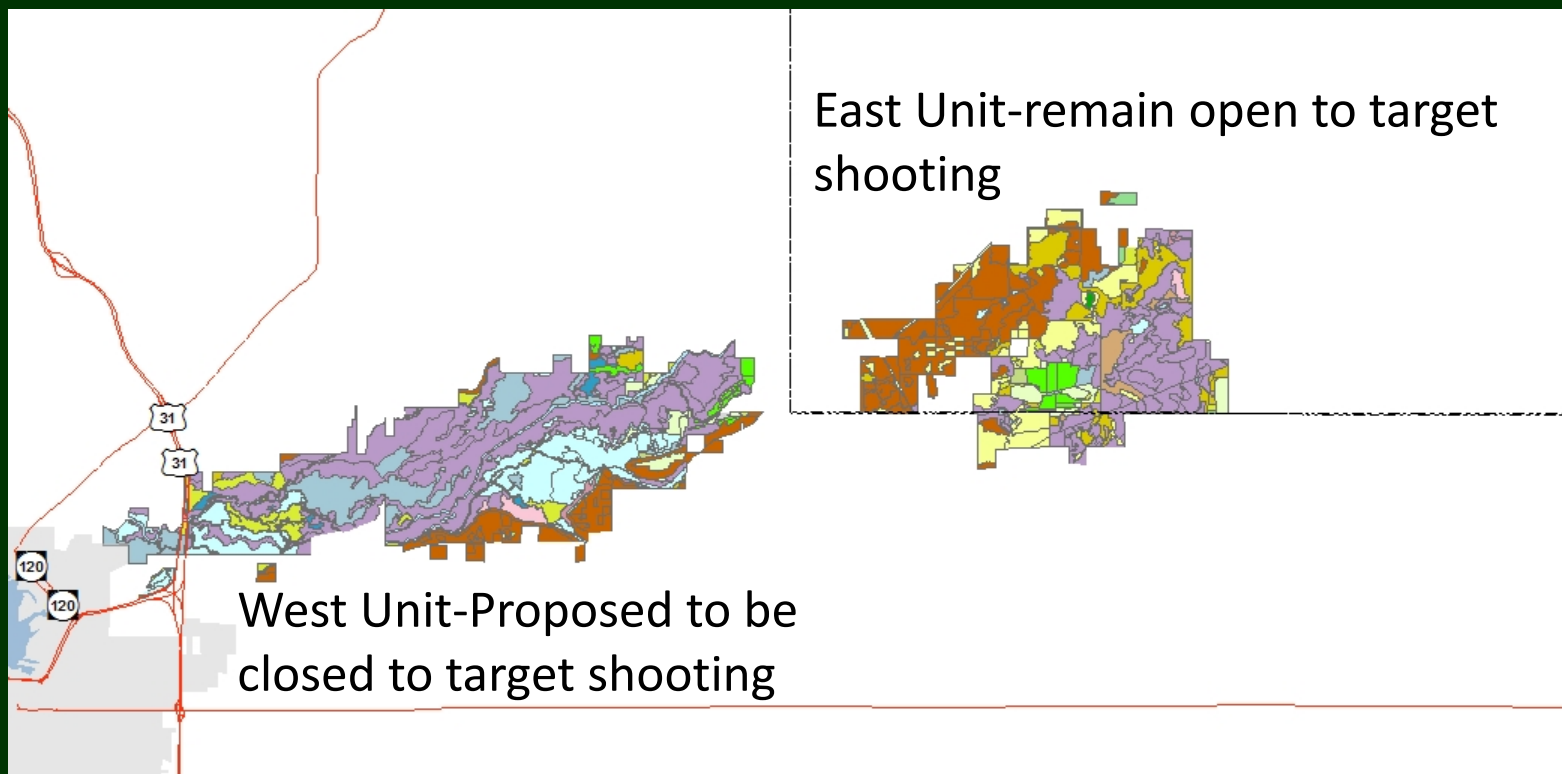


# Muskegon and Rogue River State Game Areas

- Land Use Order would prohibit target shooting in most portions of these SGAs.
- Numerous partner ranges exist in the area.
- Eliminate safety concerns.
- Eliminate target debris, damage to timber and adjacent habitat.

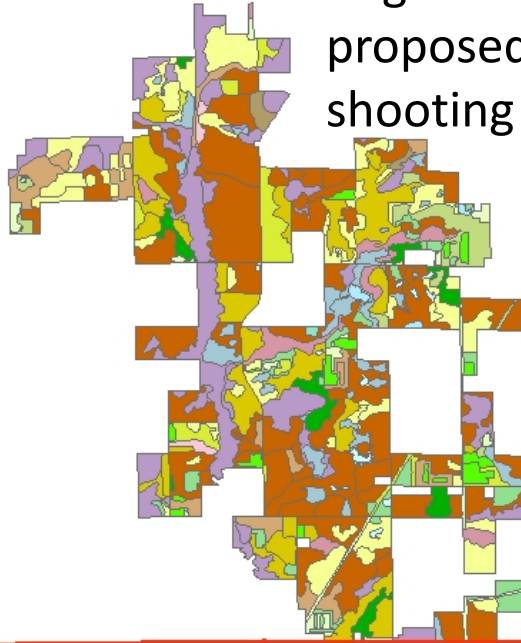








Rogue River SGA Main Unit-
