Current Wolf Management Plan

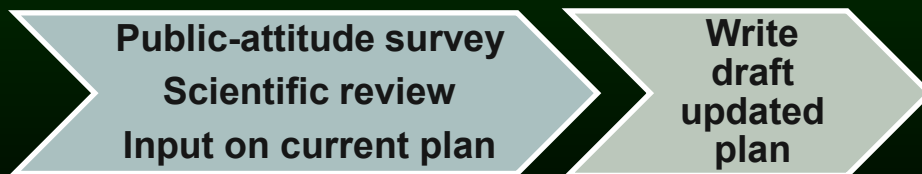
- Gather input on current Plan
 - Time required: 1-3 months
 - Public comments
 - Wolf Management Advisory Council
 - Tribal consultation

Public-attitude survey
Scientific review
Input on current plan



Updated Wolf Management Plan

- Write draft updated Plan
 - Time required: 2-4 months
 - Input from public and Tribes
 - Biological and social science



Updated Wolf Management Plan

- Gather input on draft updated Plan
 - Time required: 1-2 months
 - Public comments
 - Wolf Management Advisory Council
 - Tribal consultation



Updated Wolf Management Plan

- Finalize updated Plan
 - Time required: 2-3 months
 - Input from public, Council, and Tribes
 - NRC and Director
- Expected Completion Date
 - June 30th, 2022
