Pursuant to Section 74117(14), PA 451 of 1994, the table below summarizes the Department of Natural Resources and Environment's (DNRE) Fiscal Year 2009-2010 revenue stream from state parks motor vehicle permit fees. The state parks system did not receive any General Fund/General Purpose revenue in Fiscal Year 2009-2010, and the Michigan State Parks Endowment Fund was not impacted by the motor vehicle permit revenue stream.
