

## **Wetland Wonders Challenge Contest Terms and Conditions**

- A participating individual must agree to the terms and conditions that are listed below by the Michigan United Conservation Clubs and Michigan Department of Natural Resources.
- The Wetland Wonders Challenge will begin on October 8, 2016 and continue through February 12, 2017.
- To be entered into the Wetland Wonders Challenge Contest each individual needs to have all appropriate licenses to hunt waterfowl at an MWA in the state of Michigan.
- The Wetland Wonders Challenge punch card may be picked up at any of the seven Managed Waterfowl Hunt Areas. It includes name, phone number, email address, and driver's license or Michigan sportcard number.
- To be entered into the grand prize drawing, an individual must have registered at a minimum of three different MWAs during the same contest period and have their Wetland Wonders Challenge punch card validated by a Michigan DNR employee.
- An individual may receive additional contest entries by visiting more than three different MWA's during the same contest period. Each additional valid punch results in an additional contest entry. Visit all seven MWA's to receive the maximum of five contest entries.
- Wetland Wonders Challenge punch cards will only be validated during regular MWA check station hours and on days when managed drawings for hunt zones are conducted (i.e., days and times when there are self-registered hunts are not included).
- Following an individual's registration they will receive a commemorative leg band that is exclusive to each of the seven Managed Waterfowl Hunt Areas. Only one leg band per area will be allowed per person. The bands are available only while supplies last.
- Completed Wetland Wonders Challenge Punch Cards should be submitted to a DNR employee at an MWA. If you cannot make it to an MWA before the contest ends, you can mail your punch card to Detroit Metro Customer Service Center, Attn: Holly Vaughn Joswick, 1801 Atwater, Detroit, MI 48207.
- Upon submission of an official MUCC Wetland Wonders Challenge Contest entry form, an entry receipt will be provided via e-mail.
- If the Wetland Wonders Challenge punch card cannot be read, is lost, or destroyed, the individual forfeits their participation in the Wetland Wonders Challenge contest.
- The Wetland Wonders Challenge punch card is non-transferable.
- Seven grand prize winners will be randomly selected on February 27, 2017. Selection of the seven grand prize packages will be by order of the random selection. Winners will be notified by phone or email and given instructions to collect their prizes. Prizes must be collected within 60 days of selection or forfeiture will occur.
- Participants that submit punch cards with punches from all seven MWA's will receive a prize recognizing their achievement.
- There may be additional terms and conditions on individual prize items. Please refer to individual prize items for details.

- In the event that a minor wins a grand prize package, a legal parent or guardian will be given possession of the prize.
- The seven grand prize winners must pass background checks prior to receiving firearms. Upon notification, winners will be given instructions on how to proceed in order to receive firearm. In the event that a minor wins one of the grand prize packages, the parent or guardian will be instructed on how to receive firearms.
- MUCC and Michigan DNR employees are ineligible to participate in the Wetland Wonders Challenge contest.
- MUCC and the Michigan DNR hold the right to alter and modify the terms and conditions of the Wetland Wonders Challenge contest throughout the term of the contest.
- By participating in the Wetland Wonders Challenge contest, each participant accepts all responsibility for, and hereby releases and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless MUCC and the Michigan DNR, sponsors and their respective parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, promotion and advertising agencies, franchisees, and each of their respective officers, directors, employees, shareholders, and successors, assigns, and service providers from and against any claims, liabilities, damages, or expenses that may arise from actions taken by such participant and/or participant's participation in the contest, or for any harm or injury caused by any third party
