

Wetland Wonders Challenge II

Saginaw Bay Photo Scavenger Hunt

The Saginaw Bay Photo Scavenger Hunt is a fun way to explore Michigan's Wetland Wonders around Saginaw Bay: Shiawassee River State Game Area, Nayanquing Point State Wildlife Area, and Fish Point State Wildlife Area.

How it works:

- Sign up your team at <http://bit.ly/Z3T5G7>. There is no limit on team size so you can be a team of one or recruit all of your family and friends.
- All teams need to be signed up by midnight on 29 May 2013 to qualify for scavenger hunt prizes.
- The list of hunt items will be posted on the Michigan Waterfowl Legacy's facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/michiganwaterfowllegacy>) and the DNR's Wetland Wonders page (<http://www.michigan.gov/wetlandwonders>). Teams that find at least 65 items on the hunt list will be eligible to pick up a prize on 1 June during a Saginaw Bay area Wetland Wonders Challenge II event (watch the Wetland Wonders web site for more details).

How to hunt for items:

- Take a picture of an item on the hunt list and upload it to <http://www.flickr.com> (you'll need a Flickr account to do this, and Flickr accounts are free).

Add three tags to the photo: your **TEAM NAME**

the **NUMBER OF THE ITEM FROM THE HUNT LIST**

Please add a short description to any photos where the hunt item is difficult to see or identify.

- Each hunt item must have its own photo – you can't submit the same picture for multiple hunt items.
- All photos must be taken between 26 April and 31 May 2013.
- All photos must be taken at one of the following areas: Shiawassee River State Game Area, Nayanquing Point State Wildlife Area, and Fish Point State Wildlife Area.
- Digitally altered photos (i.e. Photoshopped) are not allowed and will be disqualified.
- At least one guided nature walk will be offered at each area during the hunt to help find and identify hunt items. There is no guarantee that all hunt items will be found during each nature walk. Watch the Wetland Wonders web page for specific dates and times of each nature walk.
- Teams can help each other find hunt items, but each team must submit its own photos.
- If you have questions about hunt items, post them on the Michigan Waterfowl Legacy's facebook page or ask your guide on one of the nature walks.
- If we like a photo, we might want to use it in future marketing for DNR wildlife conservation projects. We will contact you for permission before using any photo, but we will not be purchasing any photos. By participating in the hunt and uploading photos, you acknowledge that you understand that this is done for fun and for the purposes of participating in the scavenger hunt and does not imply any commercial or monetary relationship or obligation on the Michigan Department of Natural Resources.
- At the end of the scavenger hunt, all scavenger hunters are invited to a Saginaw Bay area Wetland Wonders Challenge II event on 1 June (watch the Wetland Wonders web site for more details). Successful hunters can pick up their prizes during this event.

How to get entered in the Wetland Wonders Challenge II Raffle:

- Everyone who participates in one of the scavenger hunt guided nature walks or comes to the Wetland Wonders Challenge II event at the end of the scavenger hunt is eligible to enter the Wetland Wonders Challenge II Raffle for one of seven ultimate Michigan experience prize packages.
- You can enter the raffle once for each event that you attend. If you go on more than one guided nature walk, you can enter more than once.
