Description:	Wexford County, Hanover Township, T24N, R11W, Section 1: Part of the Northwest One-Quarter of Section 1, Town 24 North, Range 11 West, more fully described as Commencing at the West 1/4 Corner of said Section 1; thence South 88°53'22" East, along the East and West One-Quarter line of said section, 1057.62 feet, to the Point of Beginning; thence North 01°06'38" East, 53.00 feet; thence South 88°53'22" East, 76.00 feet; thence South 01°06'38" West, 53.00 feet, to the East and West One-Quarter line; thence North 88°53'22" West, along said Quarter line, 76.00 feet, to the Point of Beginning.
PA 240 of 2018:	This parcel is north of the Mason-Arenac county line and will result in a decrease of 0.09-acre of DNR-managed lands.

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Comments:	The desired parcel is a small parcel of land adjacent to private
	ownership. This sale will resolve a structure trespass.

The proposed land disposal was recommended for approval as surplus by the Land Exchange Review Committee on June 20, 2019.

Proceeds will be deposited into the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF). The LEFF allows the Department to sell rights in land and deposit the proceeds in a fund which can then be used to acquire replacement property.

Recommendation: 1. That the land be sold to the applicant for \$1,000.00.

- 2. That the proceeds of the sale be deposited in the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF).
- 3. That the state retain aboriginal antiquities.
